#### -Love that Dies-

A church member had built a large, rough wooden cross at the front of the sanctuary for our Good Friday worship service. The service included scripture readings, hymns and anthems about Jesus' death on the cross. Candles were extinguished one by one as Jesus' last words were read, Father, "Forgive them" (Luke 23:34) "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Mark 15:34). When the reader said, "It is finished" (John 19:30), the last candle was snuffed out, leaving the room pitch black.

We sat in the dark silence. Suddenly a spotlight shone on the cross. For a second it looked as if Jesus were hanging there. Then I recognized that the man on the cross was a fellow church member. How did he get up there? I asked myself.

As part of the plan for the service, this man had climbed the cross while we sat in darkness. But the experience led me to ask about the real cross. How did Jesus get up there? In one sense, our pride, stubbornness, fear, and sinfulness put him there. But in a deeper sense, love for us took Jesus to the cross so that we could live now and eternally in the light of God.

## Recognize Signs of Heat Illness

### Heat Exhaustion

Faint or dizzy  
Excessive sweating  
Cool, pale, clammy skin  
Nausea or vomiting  
Rapid, weak pulse  
Muscle cramps

- Get to a cooler, air conditioned place
- Drink water if fully conscious
- Take a cool shower or use cold Compresses

### Heat Stroke

Throbbing headache  
No sweating  
Body temperature above 103°  
Nausea or vomiting  
Rapid, strong pluse  
May loose consciousness

Call 9-1-1

Take immediate action to cool the person until help arrises.
